EXTRACT FROM THE OLYMPIC CHARTER

- 1 The Olympic Games are held every four years. They assemble anteurs of all nations in fair and equal competition under conditions which are as perfect as possible. No discrimination is allowed against any country or person on grounds of colour, religion or polities.
- The Olympic Games celebrate an Olympiad or period of four successive years even though it has been or may be impossible to hold the Games.
- A separate cycle of Winter Games is held, comprising competitions in Winter Sports. The Winter Games are held in the same calendar year as the Gymple Games.

The first Winter Games were held in 1924 during the VIIIh Olympiad and subsequent Winter Games are nusbered in rotation as they are held.
